Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for grant of route permit under the Stage Carriage Scheme of 2016 (P-1) in view of the order dated 21.01.2020 (P-9), passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No.556 of 2020 (arising out of SLP (Civil No.22800/2017)).

At the outset, learned Counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the representation dated 20.05.2020 (P-13) is decided by the competent authority by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Innocuous prayer of the petitioner is not opposed by learned State Counsel; rather fairly submitted that representation of the petitioner would be considered and decided within a time bound manner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation dated 20.05.2020 (P-13) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 04 (four) weeks from today.
