This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.118 dated 6.12.2014 under Sections 420/ 406 IPC registered at Police Station Gidderbaha.

Vide order dated 16.7.2019, petitioner was directed to be released on interim anticipatory bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the FIR in question was registered by the police and cancellation report was submitted on 30.7.2015. On the basis of objection raised by the complainant, the same was not accepted and further investigation was done by the police. Even on the basis of further investigation, second cancellation report was submitted

to the Illaqa Magistrate on 13.5.2017. Again objections were raised by the complainant party, resulting in non acceptance of the cancellation report.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required in any further investigation of the case.

In view of above interim order dated 16.7.2020 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
