The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 24.02.2020, vide which, direction was issued to Deputy Commissioner, Barnala to ensure that appropriate necessary action was taken in the matter as per law, pursuant to the petitioner's representation dated 30.08.2019 and the exchange of correspondence between the officials, referred to *supra*.

Reply on behalf of the respondent is already on record. As per para Nos.7, 8 and 9 of the reply, the needful has been done. Even, the money has been recovered from the concerned people and FIR has also been registered against him.

In view of the same, nothing survives in the present contempt petition.

Dismissed accordingly.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the money has been recovered from SEPO and not from the Sarpanch.

In case, the petitioners are still aggrieved in any manner and looking for specific action against Sarpanch, they are at liberty to avail remedy as available to them, in law.
