This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 66 dated 14.04.2019, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Goraya, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in judicial custody for the period of last 01 year, 07 months and 28 days and he is not involved in any other case.

Learned counsel further submits that out of total 10 prosecution witnesses, only 01 witness has been examined so far, hence, on account of this reasons as well as due to Covid-19 situation, the trial is likely to take a long time in its conclusion.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of the custody certificate filed today in Court, has not disputed the factual position, however, he

opposed the bail.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, considering the fact that petitioner is in judicial custody for the last about 01 year, 07 months and 28 days; he is not involved in any other case and due to Covid-19 situation, the conclusion of trial is likely to take some time, the present petition is disposed of and the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail till 28.05.2021, on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, concerned.

However, the trial Court, after assessing the situation, if the trial has not started in ordinary course and the evidence is recorded, may cancel or may continue the interim bail granted to the petitioner till further orders.
