In the present writ petition the grievance of the petitioner is that her claim for the benefit of interest on the delayed release of the pensionary benefits, has been rejected by the respondents vide order dated 20.07.2017 (Annexure P-8), which is contrary to the settled principle of law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the similar claim, as raised in the present writ petition was raised by the similarly situated employees in CWP No.22586 of 2017, titled as “***Nirmal Singh and others v Punjab Water Resources Management and Development Corporation Limited and others***”. The said writ petition was allowed on 29.01.2020 and the interest on the delayed release of the pensionary benefits has been allowed and the claim of the petitioner in the present writ petition is squarely covered by the decision of ***Nirmal Singh's*** case (*supra*).

Learned counsel for the respondents very fairly states that the claim of the petitioners will be covered by the decision rendered by this Court in ***Nirmal Singh's*** case (*supra*) and respondents will have no objection, in case the present writ petition is disposed of in the same terms.

Keeping in view the request made by learned counsel for the parties, the present writ petition is disposed of in terms of the order passed in *Nirmal Singh's* case (*supra*).
