In the instant case, 500 tablets of Tramadol hydrochloride and 05 grams of Heroin have been recovered from the possession of the petitioner on 20.09.2019. The weight of Tramadol hydrochloride comes to 429.87grams which falls in the category of commercial quantity. The earlier application for bail has been dismissed vide order dated 14.07.2020. The first application for bail was dismissed as withdrawn on 07.02.2020. Thereafter, the second application was dismissed on merits vide order dated 14.07.2020. Thereafter, the present application has been moved. The quantity of contraband recovered from the possession of the petitioner falls in the category of commercial quantity.

As such, the stringent provisions of Section 37 of NDPS Act come into play. There is nothing to suggest that the petitioner has not committed the offence and is not likely to commit the offence while on bail. There is no change of circumstances which may justify the concession of bail to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
