Case is taken up through Video Conferencing on account of
COVID-2019.

By filing this petition, quashing of FIR No.89 dated 10.09.2020
registered under Sections 420, 447, 511, 379 and 120-B IPC at Police Station
S.G.N. Dev Thermal Plant, District Bathinda, and all other subsequent
proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners has been sought on the basis
of compromise dated 30.09.2020 (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 09.10.2020, parties were directed to appear before
the trial Court/Area Magistrate on 09.11.2020 for recording their statements and
trial Court was to sent its report regarding the genuineness of compromise.

Report of learned JMIC, Bathinda received wherein it is stated that
genuine and true compromise has been entered into between the parties and
which is voluntary, without any coercion or undue influence from either side.

In view thereof, the petition is allowed. FIR No.89 dated
10.09.2020 registered under Sections 420, 447, 511, 379 and 120-B at Police

Station S.G.N. Dev Thermal Plant, District Bathinda, and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
