The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.136 dated 8.9.2020, under Sections 323, 324, 506, 504, 452, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Jhansa, District Kurukshetra.

It is submitted by the counsel for the petitioners that it is a case of version and cross version, in which petitioner No.1 has also got lodged an FIR against the other side for causing eight injuries to her, besides two injuries to petitioner No.2. Still further, it is submitted that even as per the case of the prosecution, the petitioners are alleged to have caused injuries with brick and danda only. The alleged injuries are simple in nature. The petitioners will joined the investigation. Hence, the petitioners deserve the concession of anticipatory bail.

The counsel for the State, being instructed by ASI Naresh Kumar, submits that the names of the petitioners are specifically mentioned in the FIR. However, it is not disputed that there is a cross version as well, involving eight injuries to petitioner No.1 and two injuries to petitioner No.2. It is also not disputed that the injuries attributed to the petitioners in the present case are simple in nature.

In view of the above, but without commenting any further on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. In the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds/surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
