Result of the petitioners for the post of LDC in general category in UHBVNL/DHBVNL against advertisement No.03/2016 category No.03, has been produced in sealed cover, which on opening reveals petitioner No.1 to have secured 109 out of 200 marks while petitioner No.2 secured 78 out of 200 marks as against 113/117 marks secured by the last selected candidates in UHBVNL/DHBVNL respectively. Moreover, the last candidate in the waiting list in UHBVNL/DHBVNL secured 100/110 marks.

2. In the light of the position as noted above, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the writ petition pending as petitioner No.2 secured lesser marks than the marks obtained by the last selected candidate even in the waiting list. Since petitioner No.1 secured 109 marks, the same entitles him to be placed in the waiting list for consideration for appointment to the post of LDC in UHBVNL.

3. Learned Sr. DAG states that in the circumstances, the writ petition be disposed of by directing the respondents to take follow up action on the result of petitioner No.1 in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to take follow up action on the result of petitioner No.1, in accordance with law.
5. Result be resealed and returned to learned Sr. DAG, Haryana.
