Petitioner had approached this Court praying for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the petitioner employment on compassionate ground as per the policy. In pursuance thereto, petitioner had served a notice through counsel dated 07.08.2020 (Annexure P-5) but the same was asserted in the petition to be not decided.

Counsel for the State has sent, through email, a decision taken by the Executive Engineer, P.H. Engineering Department, Division No. 1, Jhajjar dated 05.10.2020, whereby the legal notice dated 07.08.2020 (Annexure P-5) stands decided and the claim of the petitioner stands rejected.

In the light of the decision on the legal notice dated 07.08.2020 by the Executive Engineer, P.H. Engineering Department, Division No. 1,

Jhajjar dated 05.10.2020, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to take appropriate steps, in accordance with law, to challenge the order/decision dated 05.10.2020 taken by the Executive Engineer, P.H. Engineering Department, Division No. 1, Jhajjar.
