The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 74 dated 5.5.2020 under Sections 323, 308 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the FIR in question on the basis of totally baseless and fabricated allegations. He further contends that even on a perusal of the FIR, only brick bat blows have been attributed to him. He further submits that on account of some previous enmity with one Narinder Pal Singh, a neighbour of the complainant, the petitioner has been implicated in the case in hand. He further submits that the trial is unlikely to conclude in the near future, as only challan has been filed till date.

Per contra, learned State counsel, while opposing the grant of

regular bail to the petitioner has submitted on instructions that there are serious allegations levelled against the petitioner of inflicting injuries on the head, for which the injured had to undergo a head surgery.

Heard.

In view of the above, the petitioner does not deserve the concession of regular bail. The instant petition is dismissed. However, anything observed hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
