1. Within less than two months, the Petitioners are back in this Court with a second writ petition. Earlier, the Petitioners had filed CWP No. 11284 of 2020 (O&M), which was dismissed as withdrawn on 5th August, 2020 by the following order:

“With the consent of learned Counsel for the parties, the matter is being taken up and heard via video conferencing (Webex App software).

The petition filed by the Petitioners is permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to take up and pursue their representation that they have filed before the Chief Secretary, State of Punjab.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.”

2. It appears that after the above order was passed, the Petitioners sent a representation on 10th August, 2020 followed by a reminder on 3rd September, 2020 and an e-mail on 17th September, 2020.

3. Given the above timeline, the Court is of the view that the Petitioners ought to follow up the matter with the Respondents more rigorously, instead of rushing again to the Court seeking the same relief. The liberty that has already been granted by this Court to the Petitioners by the order dated 5th

August, 2020, has to be taken to its logical end. The Court is therefore not inclined to pass any order at this stage in the present petition.

4. The petition is disposed of with the above observations.
