JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the FIR No. 38 dated 09.02.2019 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women, District Police Commisionerate Ludhiana on the basis of an affidavit of compromise.

Learned counsel has put in an appearance on behalf of complainant and submits that no compromise has been effected between the parties since the petitioners herein did not adhere to the terms and conditions as specified therein. It is also submitted that the petition filed under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act also stands dismissed.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the fact that the inherent powers of this Court have been invoked for having the FIR quashed on the basis of a compromise between the parties. The petition itself would not be sustainable as no compromise is coming to the effect.

Consequently, the instant petition seeking quashing of the FIR along with all consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise stands dismissed.
