This petition has been filed seeking quashing of FIR no.484 dated 25.08.2020 (as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom), registered at Police Station Karnal City, District Karnal, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 406, 420 and 506 of the IPC, and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, 2009, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioner and respondents no.2 and 3. A copy of the compromise deed has been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition.

Pursuant to the order of this Court dated 08.10.2020, a report of the learned ACJM, Karnal, dated 26.10.2020, has been received, stating therein that the petitioner, as also respondents no.2 and 3, i.e. the complainant in the FIR in question, appeared before that court and suffered statements admitting to the compromise reached between them and as per the assessment of that court, the compromise arrived at between them, is without any undue influence, pressure or coercion.

A reply has also been filed by the Superintendent of Police,

Karnal, stating to the effect that other than the FIR in question, and FIR no.350, dated 20.06.2020, registered at Police Station City Karnal, for the alleged commission of the same offences, there is no other FIR found to be registered against the petitioner, with that FIR also having been quashed by this court vide an order dated 14.10.2020, passed in CRM-M-24276 of 2020.

Mr. Aggarwal, learned counsel for respondents no.2 and 3, also does not deny the factum of the compromise reached between the parties.

Consequently, also looking at the nature of the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioner, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.484 dated 25.08.2020, registered against the petitioner at Police Station Karnal City, District Karnal, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 406,420, and 506 of the IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, 2009, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
