The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.279 dated 02.08.2020 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 506, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Karnal Civil Lines, District Karnal.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court, by order dated 09.10.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Dharmapal, contends that the petitioner has joined investigation and the car and the RC have been recovered from her.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner having joined investigation and the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 09.10.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
