The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Petitioners, namely, Ghanshyam @ Ghanshyam Dass and Pushkar @ Pushkar Narang have filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.166 dated 18.07.2020 under Sections 323, 341, 328, 307, 506, 447, 120-B and 427 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Ratia, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated October 09, 2020 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baldev Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that custodial interrogation of the petitioners is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated October 09, 2020 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
