Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.33 dated 07.06.2019 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station, Women Cell, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Vide order dated 31.10.2019, the case was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. However, the matter could not be resolved between the parties.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner states that the present petition has been rendered infructuous, as the matter has otherwise been

compromised between the parties and pursuant thereto, a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 has been filed for dissolution of marriage.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.

However, in case the complainant feels that the assertion so made by counsel for the petitioner is incorrect or contrary to record, she will be at liberty to approach the police authorities so as to pursue the FIR in question in accordance with law.
