Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.59 dated 06.02.2020 under Sections 395, 397 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station DLF, Sector-29, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, three persons hired the auto of the complainant for a fair of Rs.50/-, but on way, by showing a country-made pistol, they snatched the auto. It is further submitted that the petitioner is first offender and is in custody for the last more than five months and challan stands presented. Learned counsel has relied upon the orders dated 17.09.2020 passed in CRM-M-17063-2020 and CRM-M-18262-2020, vide which co-accused Shahrukh and Illias have been granted the concession of regular bail.

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Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate dated 16.11.2020 in the Court today and has not disputed the factual position.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting anything on merits of the case and considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
