Vide order dated 13.10.2020 learned State counsel had been directed to apprise the Court as to whether the petitioner was involved in any other criminal cases.

In the affidavit filed by the State on behalf of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Old, Gurugram, it has been stated that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case much less any under NDPS Act.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.294 dated 28.07.2020 registered under Section 20(b)(ii)(B) of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Sector 5, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner has been in custody since 28.07.2020 and the trial is unlikely to conclude in the near future as only challan has been filed till date.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rattan Pal has apprised the Court that final report under Section 173 Cr.PC was filed on 25.09.2020 and the charges are likely to be framed shortly.

Heard.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 13.10.2020, is made absolute subject to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
