The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner has preferred this petition for issuance of an appropriate direction to respondents No.3 to 6 to hand over the investigation of the case bearing FIR No.188 dated 08.07.2020 registered under Sections 328, 376-D, 506 IPC at Police Station Kalayat, District Kaithal to respondent No.2 i.e. State Crime Branch, Kaithal or to some independent agency.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajat Gautam, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Kaur submits that the police after verification has

prepared a cancellation report on 24.08.2020. Now the said cancellation report is pending before the Superintendent of Police/respondent No.4 for approval. The cancellation report shall be submitted to the competent Court in accordance with law.

Since the investigation is complete and the police has prepared cancellation report, therefore, in the event of filing the same before the competent Court/Illaqa Magistrate, the petitioner would be having remedy of filing protest petition in accordance with law.

In view of aforesaid position, there is no necessity of issuing any direction to the official respondents except to ensure that final report/cancellation report be submitted to the competent Court at the earliest.
