Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.42 dated 16.03.2020, registered at Police Station Urban Estate, Patiala, District Patiala, under Sections 399,402 IPC (Sections 411,483 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, added later on).

On 09.10.2020, a Coordinate Bench of this Court passed the following order:-

“Relies upon order dated 25.08.2020 passed in CRM-M-24235-2020 and submits that the alleged role of the petitioner is identical to that of the petitioner therein.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sidakmeet Singh Sandhu, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and waives service.

Adjourned to 24.11.2020.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join investigation with the Investigating Officer on 16.10.2020 at 10.00 a.m. and cooperate therewith. In the event of his arrest, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/SHO concerned subject to his

compliance of the conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 09.10.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 09.10.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
