MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has filed this writ petition under Articles 226/227 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 for providing him protection as private respondent are trying to implicate the petitioner in a false criminal case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that his wife and daughter purchased property from Gurpreet Kaur and others and in the said property, theft was committed, whereupon a case FIR No.55 dated 06.05.2020 under Sections 457 and 380 IPC stands registered at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda against Surinderjit Singh (respondent No.4). He contends that on the asking of respondent No.4, the other respondents are likely to implicate the petitioner in a false case. He submits that the petitioner has already given a representation dated 19.09.2020 (Annexure P-1) to Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, however, no action has been taken upon the same. He prays that necessary directions for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioner be issued.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court finds

that a case has already been registered at the instance of the petitioner

against respondent No.4 and the bald averments made in the petition are not supported by any convincing material, therefore, the same do not inspire any confidence.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any reason to exercise the extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

The petition is dismissed.
