Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner-Vishal @ Shalu son of Vijay Sharma, aged about 20 years, prays for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.0671, dated 16.08.2020, registered under Section 379A IPC, at Police Station Thanesar City, District Kurukshetra.

As per the case of the prosecution, 3 boys travelling on a motorcycle snatched gold chain from the neck of the first informant on 16.08.2020, at about 8:30 PM.

The petitioner is sought to be indicted as an accused on the statement of a co-accused, Rakesh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the gold chain has already been recovered from a goldsmith. He further contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated.

Shri Arun Beniwal, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has opposed the prayer on the ground that the petitioner is involved in a heinous crime.

On a Court question, Sh. Arun Beniwal, DAG, Haryana, has admitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 24.08.2020 and has no criminal antecedents.

The conclusion of the trial is likely to take time.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 24.08.2020 and conclusion of the trial is likely to take time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
