Petition herein is under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 for taking appropriate legal action against private respondents as they have allegedly committed cognizable offences.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that private respondents want to grab land of the family of the petitioner. Respondents No.4 to 6 with an intention to kill the child of the petitioner entered into house of the petitioner. Respondent No.6 armed with gandasi gave gandasi blow upon the petitioner hitting her left arm. The respondents No.4 and 5 also gave stick blows on the back of the petitioner. Respondent No.10 too had brutally beaten the petitioner. After that, petitioner had to be admitted in the Civil Hospital, Jalalabad for treatment.

3. Learned counsel further submits that in order to help the accused persons, no FIR was lodged and only DDR No.29 dated 27.07.2020 was recorded. He submits that role of the police officials is biased and no suitable action has been taken against them.

4. In these circumstances, petitioner also submitted a representation dated 02.09.2020 (Annexure P-2), but police did not act in terms of law.

5. Hence, this petition has been preferred for conducting impartial inquiry through Special Investigation Team.

6. Heard.

7. Taking into the consideration the averments contained in the petition, it is not a case warranting interference by this Court under extra ordinary jurisdiction.

8. Petition is disposed of with an observation that non-indulgence of this Court shall not preclude the competent authority to look into the representation dated 02.09.2020 (Annexure P-2), which is stated to have been filed by the petitioner, in accordance with law.

9. Disposed of accordingly.
