1. Result of the petitioners for the post of Lower Division Clerk in UHBVNL/ DHBVNL, against Advertisement No. 3/2016, category No. 3 has been produced in sealed cover in Court alongwith cut-off marks obtained by the last selected candidate which on opening reveals petitioner No.1 to have secured 116 out of 200 marks in the SC category as against 79/78 marks respectively of the last candidate selected while petitioner No.2 to have secured 113 out of 200 marks in the BCB category as against 82/86 marks respectively of the last candidate selected in BCB category.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the marks obtained by the petitioners, the writ petition may be disposed of by directing the respondents to take follow up action, in accordance with law.

3. Learned Sr. DAG, Haryana states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioners.

4. In view of the above circumstances, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to take follow-up action on the result of the petitioners in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

5. Writ petition disposed of in the afore-mentioned terms.
