The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of interim regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for a period of 04 weeks in case bearing FIR No.1 dated 19.01.2020 under Sections 21/61/85 of NDPS Act registered at Police Station State Special Operations Cell Fazilka, District Fazilka on the ground to attend marriage of his younger brother.

Notice of motion was issued on 13.10.2020 to obtain factual report from the police.

Now the police has submitted its report to show that no marriage of Harish Mehta, brother of the petitioner is going to be held on 28/29.10.2020.

It has also been reported that a girl namely Divya Sehgal daughter of Rakesh Kumar is the friend of Harish Mehta, but there is no marriage programme/ring ceremony which is to be held, as claimed by the petitioner.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
