The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioners as Staff Nurses.

Counsel for the petitioners would contend that the petitioners herein are Staff Nurses and would be entitled to regularization of their services as has been allowed in CWP No.11427 of 2015. At this stage, counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer to the extent that legal notice dated 22.06.2020 (Annexure P-11) should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Simran Grewal, AAG Punjab, who is appearing through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Let a copy of the paper book be supplied to her through e-mail or on whatsapp group during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant writ petition by directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 22.06.2020 (Annexure P-11) of the petitioners by passing a speaking order keeping in view the judgment rendered by this court in CWP No.11427 of 2015, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law. If the petitioners found entitled to the relief claimed, necessary orders to ensue within a period of one month thereafter.
