The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.115 dated 23.07.2020 registered under Sections 324, 452, 34 IPC at Police Station Talwandi, Chaudhrian.

On 09.10.2020, following order was passed:-

"Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner/accused-Paramjit Singh @ Pamma has been attributed only simple injury and that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Notice of motion for 04.12.2020.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall, however, join the investigation within a period of 15 days and he shall also abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 17.10.2020 and he is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 09.10.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
