GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

Petitioners – Sunil Kumar and 7 others have jointly filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer to set aside the order dated 14.08.2020 (Annexure P-5) qua petitioners only, vide which the petitioners have been transferred at faraway places in contravention to the policy guidelines as well as in contravention to the Right of Children to free and compulsory Education Act, 2009. Further, stay of filing of vacant posts in pursuance of list/notice (Annexure P-9) has been sought.

Learned counsel for the petitioners based on pleadings, submits that for the same/similar grievances as made in the present petition, the petitioners had submitted a representations dated 21.08.2020 and 25.08.2020 (Annexure P-11 and P-12 respectively), but till date, no action has been taken. Learned counsel, further makes reference to Policy dated 06.03.2020 (Annexure P-7) and submits that the Competent Authority is expected to take action as per the aforementioned policy.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Ms. Palika Monga, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State. She also brings to the notice of this Court, order dated 16.09.2020 passed in CWP No.14471 of 2020.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director, Secondary Education Department, Haryana, to get the matter examined from the Competent Authority and decide the same in accordance with law, keeping in view the Policy dated 06.03.2020 (Annexure P-7), amended Policy dated 07.08.2020 (Annexure P-8) and also keeping in view the order dated 16.09.2020, passed by this Court and take a decision as expeditiously as possible, maximum within a period of 07 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
