1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Learned counsel contends that vide order dated 08.07.2020 CWP No.9408 of 2020 was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide the representation submitted by the petitioner within a period of 02 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order but despite lapse of the aforementioned period of time, needful has not been done, therefore, the respondent is liable to be proceeded against under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for intentional and willful defiance of the aforesaid orders.

3. Notice to the respondent to show cause as to why proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 be not initiated against him for intentional and willful defiance of order dated 08.07.2020 in CWP No.9408 of 2020.

notice on behalf of the respondent and has produced copy of order dated 17.12.2020. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that he does not press the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such, with liberty to challenge order dated 17.12.2020, by way of appropriate proceeding, in accordance with law.

5. In view of the position as noted above and the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is ***disposed of***, as not pressed with the liberty, as prayed for.
