Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 62 dated 04.07.2019 registered under Sections 21/29 of NDPS Act and Section 61/85 of NDPS added subsequently, at Police Station STF, District STF Wing, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was wrongly and illegally involved in the present case. The petitioner was indicted in the present case, on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused Ranjit Singh, who was apprehended at the spot, with 40 grams of

Heroin. It was disclosed by co-accused Ranjit Singh that he has taken the contraband from the petitioner and Sunny, who used to supply the same on road side.

Copy of custody certificate by way of affidavit dated 22.12.2020 of the Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Rupnagar, submitted by the learned State counsel through email, is taken on record.

Learned State counsel submits that though the petitioner was indicted in the present case on the disclosure statement of co-accused Ranjit Singh, yet he along with co-accused Sunny were apprehended and 2 Kgs of *Heroin* was recovered from the dash board of the car, which was being driven by the petitioner and co-accused Sunny was sitting on the conductor seat.

At this, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
