Prayer in the petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner with effect from the date similarly situated employees have been regularized as also to grant seniority and backwages.

2. Learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab has produced a copy of order dated 14.2.2020 in Court as per which the services of the petitioner have been regularized w.e.f. 08.05.2019. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances, the writ petition be disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioner to submit a comprehensive representation vis-à-vis claim for consequential benefits.

3. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of as not calling for any further orders in view of order dated 14.0.2.2020 granting regularization to the petitioner w.e.f. 08.05.2019. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to pursue his claim before the respondents for grant of consequential benefits in accordance with law.
