By way of this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C, the petitioner sought grant of regular (interim) bail for three months (90 days) in relation to FIR No.08 dated 08.01.2020 on the file of Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad, registered under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic and Substances Act, 1985. The first regular bail application filed by the petitioner was dismissed by this Court on 07.05.2020.

The Sessions Court at Fatehabad granted interim bail to the petitioner on 29.05.2020 as she had was pregnant and was to deliver a child shortly. The petitioner gave birth to a child on 07.07.2020. Thereafter, the Sessions Court refused her extension of bail, *vide* order dated 25.09.2020.

The present petition was filed on 29.09.2020 but was not listed for hearing till 10.11.2020. While so, Ms. Harsh Rekha Kapoor, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, would inform this Court that the petitioner was arrested on 03.11.2020.

In that view of the matter, as the petitioner seems to have sought bail for a limited period in extension of the interim bail granted to her by the Sessions Court, the present petition has become infructuous and is accordingly dismissed.
