Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 146 dated 27.06.2020, under Sections 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short) (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

On 08.10.2020, a Coordinate Bench passed the following order :-

"Heard through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 146 dated 27.06.2020, under Sections 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is

alleged to have caused simple injury on the left hand of the complainant. The injury for which offence under Section 326 IPC has been invoked is not attributed to the petitioner. He also contends that he shall seek instruction as to whether without any prejudice to his rights and contentions, the petitioner would be willing to monetarily compensate the complainant. He further contends that efforts shall be made to settle the matter amicably.

Issue notice to the respondent.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Senior DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

List on 05.11.2020 along with CRM-M No. 30940 of 2020.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the investigating/arresting officer and join investigation.

In the event of his arrest, the investigating/arresting officer shall release the petitioner on ad interim bail subject to his satisfaction. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. ”.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 08.10.2020 passed by the Coordinate Bench, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Karamjeet Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 08.10.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
