The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to issue appointment letter to the petitioner on the post of Primary Teacher.

Counsel for the petitioner would contend that the petitioner is entitled to be appointed as Primary Teacher in terms of the judgment rendered in CWP No.12938 of 2014. It is also contended that the petitioner has already submitted her biometrics on 25.04.2018, however, as on date, appointment has not been offered. At this stage, counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to the extent that legal notice dated 08.01.2020 (Annexure P-25) should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. S.S. Pannu, DAG Haryana, who is appearing through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Let a copy of the paper book be supplied to him through e-mail or on whatsapp group during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant writ petition by directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 08.01.2020 (Annexure P-25) of the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
