as well as the appeal.

COCp-2144-2020

The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of
the order dated 21.9.2020.

It is not disputed that the order has since been complied with.
The vehicle has been released to the petitioner.

In view of the same, no useful purpose would be served to
proceed with the contempt petition. The contempt petition is dismissed
accordingly.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that although the order was passed way back on 21.9.2020 with a direction to immediately entrust the vehicle to the petitioner, the respondents released the same as late as on 3.12.2020 after almost three months of the deposit of the amount on 23.9.2020 itself, which has caused loss to the petitioner.

If it is so, the petitioner is at liberty to avail remedy for claiming damages etc. from whoever is responsible in accordance with law.

However, learned counsel for the respondents while explaining the delay submitted that it was procedural delay as the vehicle was with the receiver.

As the vehicle in question has been released to the appellant, the present appeal has become infructuous.

Accordingly, the present appeal is dismissed as infructuous.
