Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.10 dated 07.01.2017, registered under Section 406 IPC, at Police Station Pinjore and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of settlement (Annexure P-3) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 11.02.2020, no due certificate from Punjab National Bank-respondent No.1 and short reply by way of affidavit of Ramesh Gulia, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Kalka, admitting the correctness of said certificate, on behalf of respondent-State have been filed. Same are taken on record. Be tagged at appropriate place.

Another letter issued to Station House Officer, Pinjore, by respondent No.1-Bank, shows that total loan amount has been cleared.

Therefore, in view of above and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony between the parties, FIR No.10 dated 07.01.2017, registered under Section 406 IPC, at Police Station Pinjore (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed.

Disposed of accordingly.
