1. Result of the petitioner for the post of Lower Division Clerk in UHBVNL/ DHBVNL, against Advertisement No. 3/2016, category No. 3 has been produced in sealed cover in Court alongwith cut-off marks obtained by the last selected candidate which on opening reveals petitioner to have secured 116 out of 200 marks in the General category as against 113/117 marks respectively of the last candidate selected in UHBVNL/DHBVNL.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the marks obtained by the petitioner, the writ petition may be disposed of by directing the respondents to take follow up action, in accordance with law.

3. Learned Sr. DAG, Haryana states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

4. In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to take follow-up action on the result of the petitioner
