HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.34 dated 22.04.2019, registered at Police Station Talwara, District Hoshiarpur, under Sections 353 and 186 IPC and Sections 325, 323, 308, 341 and 34 IPC (added later on).

On 12.07.2019, a Coordinate Bench of this Court passed the following order:

“Notice of motion for 11.11.2019.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner

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shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Arresting/Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 12.07.2019 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ram Singh, submits that although there were injuries on the person of complainant, but have not been attributed to the present petitioner. Moreover, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

At this stage, learned counsel for complainant points out that there were six injuries on the person of complainant, out of which, three were fractures and two were declared grievous in nature.

Keeping in view the facts that the petitioner has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from her, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 12.07.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

However, nothing stated above shall be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
