The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of blanket anticipatory bail in a case which may be registered against the petitioners on the complaint filed by respondent No.4-Payal Malik before the SHO, Police Station Women Cell, Mohali and before the SHO, Police Station, Dhakoli, Zirakpur, District Mohali.

A bare perusal of the paper book shows that although the respondent No.4 is stated to have moved the police against the petitioners, however, the said complaint made by respondent No.4 has not yet been converted into the FIR. Since, the court cannot presume the nature and degree of allegations, which might crop up against the

petitioners, therefore, this court cannot grant any blanket anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed.
