The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.109 dated 09.03.2020 under Sections 379-B, 120-B IPC and under Section 25 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Quilla, District Panipat.

Petitioner was nominated on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused namely Sawan, Sarwar, Muhit @ Pindi and Sunil @ Sunny.

Petitioner was not amongst the accused, who have snatched an amount of Rs.10,000/- from the complainant along with gold chain.

According to the disclosure statement, few days prior to the incident, the petitioner participated in the planning, but on the day of commission of offence, he did not associate with the other co-accused due to some reason.

Petitioner is in custody since 11.06.2020.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Vinod Kumar submits that name of the petitioner came to be disclosed by co-accused and an amount of Rs.1000/- has been recovered from the petitioner.

Challan has already been presented, but charges have not been framed.

Owing to the situation arising out of pandemic COVID-19 and without meaning anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/concerned Duty Magistrate.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.
