Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of Pandemic COVID-19.

Through this petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for quashing the action of respondents not to release the retiral benefits (i.e. earned leave encashment and GIS), without any reason.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction may be issued to respondent No.3-Director Elementary Education Haryana to decide his claim as raised in the representation dated 26.08.2019 (Annexure P-1), in the light of instructions contained in Office Memorandum dated 05.05.2008 (Annexure P-5).

Without commenting upon the merits of this case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in

the representation dated 26.08.2019 (Annexure P-1), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3-Director Elementary Education Haryana to decide the said representation in the light of instructions contained in Office Memorandum dated 05.05.2008 (Annexure P-5) within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of said representation, the same be paid to him without any further delay preferably within one month thereafter.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
