1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.4 to 11 and not to harass the petitioner and initiate further legal proceedings against the private respondents on application (Annexure P-3) moved by the petitioner.

2. A perusal of the paper book shows that the real dispute between the parties is something else. The present petition has been filed with an oblique motive to avoid the consequences of the dispute with respondents. There is nothing on record to substantiate the assertion of the petitioner that she is apprehending threat to her life and liberty.

3. Needless to say that for her grievance, which otherwise is mentioned in the petition, the petitioner is having alternate remedy.

4. Hence the present petition is dismissed.
