This order shall dispose of five writ petitions i.e. CWP Nos. 13646, 13212, 12828, 13158, 13644 and 13649 2017. For ready reference, facts have been taken from CWP No. 13646 of 2017.

Petitioners-Sanjeev Kumar Kaushik and two others, have filed the present writ petition, *inter alia*, with a prayer to quash the impugned result (Annexure P-8) only to the extent the names of the petitioners have not been included in the same despite clearing the Physical Test. It has been further prayed that the decision to declare the petitioners “as not qualified” in running test for the post of Male constable, be quashed.

The records of the case show that notice of motion was issued on 08.06.2017 and an interim direction was given to allow the petitioners to participate in the written test provisionally and result of the said test was ordered to be declared after the permission of this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that during the pendency of the writ petition the petitioners have taken the written test however, they could not reach the cut off marks of the last selected candidates.

In this view of the matter, the present petitions have become infructuous and the same are disposed of as such.
