[1] Result of petitioner Nos.1 and 3 for the post of Lower Division Clerk against Advt. No.3/2016, Category No.03 for UHBVNL/DHBVNL has been produced in sealed cover in Court today which on opening reveals petitioner No.1 to have secured 88 marks out of 200 in BCB Category while petitioner No.3 is shown to have secured 91 marks out of 200 also in the BCB Category as against cut-off last selected candidate in the BCB Category having secured 82 marks.

[2] Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of the aforementioned position, the writ petition may be disposed of by directing respondent to take follow-up action on the basis of result of petitioner Nos.1 and 3.

[3] Learned Sr. DAG states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioners.

[4] In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent to take follow-up action in view of the declaration of the result of the post of Lower Division Clerk against Advt. No.3/2016, Category No.03 of UHBVNL/DHBVNL qua petitioner Nos.1 and 3 in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.

[5] At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners prays that liberty be granted to petitioner No.1 to file a separate writ petition qua claim for the post of Upper Division Clerk.

[6] In view of the prayer of learned counsel for the petitioners, liberty is granted to petitioner No.1 to file a separate writ petition qua the aforementioned claim.
