Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This petitioner-Hansraj @ Hansa son of Nand Lal prays for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.221, dated 19.03.2019, registered under Section 147/148/149/186/307/332/353/506 IPC, at Police Station City Bhiwani, Tehsil and District Bhiwani.

The first bail application of the petitioner was dismissed on 22.10.2019 with the following order:-

“Petitioner prays for regular bail in FIR No. 221, dated 19.03.2019 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 186, 307, 332, 353 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station City Bhiwani, Tehsil and District Bhiwani.

Learned State counsel has filed affidavit of Virender Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (HQ), Bhiwani.

In the aforesaid affidavit, it has been stated that the petitioner is habitual offender and involved in as many as 25 cases and he has been convicted in 06 out of total 25 cases. He further informed the Court that prosecution evidence is being recorded.

Keeping in view the facts in the present case this Court is not inclined to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner. However, learned trial Court is

requested to make sincere endeavor to conclude the trial Court within period of 6 months.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been, in fact, convicted in 5 cases and not in 6 cases.

Be that as it may. No fresh ground for granting the concession of bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
