Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.154 dated 03.08.2020 under Sections 148, 341, 323, 325, 307, 506 read with Section 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Rajound, Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the petitioners have caused injuries to complainant Dharamveer and victim Sandeep. It is further submitted that in fact, the petitioners and the complainant belong to an extended family and now the matter has been compromised between them in order to maintain peace and harmony in the village.

Learned State counsel has submitted that one of the injury is on the head, however, there is no specific opinion of the doctor whether it was dangerous to life.

Learned counsel for the complainant acknowledged that there is a compromise between the parties, as they are closely related to each other and are residents of the same village.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting anything on merits of the case and considering the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties and there is no specific opinion of the doctor regarding the injury sustained by the victim, which was declared to be dangerous to life, this petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing their bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
