The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 for protection of the life and liberty of the petitioner and to save him from unnecessary harassment at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

A perusal of the paper book shows that there is a dispute relating to a rented premises of the petitioner. The petitioner has alternate remedies for getting the possession of the premises from the respondents. The aspect of life and liberty has unnecessarily been invoked in the matter for an oblique purpose of creating pressure upon the respondents.
