The present petition has been filed by petitioner-Deepak, *inter alia*, with the prayer to direct the respondent to allow the petitioner to participate in the selection process and interview cum Personality Test to be held in the year 2017, for the post of Constable Male (General Duty).

On 03.07.2017, notice of motion was issued. It was directed that in the meanwhile, the respondent-Commission would not fill up at least one post of Constable in the general category.

The respondent-Commission had filed a short reply though Sh. Rajeev Dudeja, Secretary (Legal), Haryana Staff Selection Commission dated 26.03.2018. In the said reply, special reference to para 5 has been made that the last shortlisted candidate in General category has secured 54.90 marks out of 90 mark. The grand total of the petitioner however out of 90 mark is 54.15 marks. On the basis thereof it has been averred that petitioner has obtained less marks than the last shortlisted candidate in his

category and has prayed that the writ petition deserves to be dismissed.

This Court on 26.04.20218 passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for a short accommodation to examine the matter, in the wake of the stand, set out in paragraph 5, of the written statement, filed on behalf of the respondents.

Adjourned to 21.05.2018.”

Since there is no dispute raised regarding the factual position narrated above, no further orders are called for.

Writ petition is disposed of as such.
