The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Sukhminder Kaur, stated to be aged 73 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of direction to the official respondents to grant police protection to the petitioner, so that the petitioner shall harvest her paddy crops and shall sow wheat crops for the next crop season and further to direct the official respondents not to implicate the petitioner in a false cases at the time of harvesting of paddy crop and sowing wheat crop by the police authorities in connivance with the private respondents No.10 to 12.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the same/similar grievance as made in the petition, the petitioner has submitted a representation (Annexure P-12) before The Senior Superintendent of Police

(Rural), Ludhiana.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Anju Sharma Kaushik, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 9.

In view of the above, without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioner approaches the police authorities concerned, with above representation (Annexure P-12) or any other representation being filed before the Competent Authority concerned, the same shall be got examined by The Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Ludhiana (respondent No.5), as expeditiously as possible, preferably within one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order, in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent by the Registry to The Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Ludhiana (respondent No.5), through e-mail or any other mode, so as to enable the said authority to do the needful expeditiously.

Ordered accordingly.
